Most of the club's activities tend to be based on road cycling, although some members are also involved in mountain and track biking.

Many members are active in sportives, including local events as well as continental rides such as L'Etape du Tour, the Marmotte and the Maratona dles Dolomites. Club members have ridden the Raid Pyrenean and even the Paris/Brest/Paris long distance audax ride. But some just ride to a local cafe and enjoy a chat!

Members are more than happy to give encouragement, advice and help to new members on training, equipment or any other aspect of cycling.

The club also helps to organise races and club members take part in the Surrey League racing.

There is a social side to the club and during the winter there are events including an annual dinner and prize-giving as well as bowling, etc.

- The club has regular time trials on Saturdays throughout the year and Thursday evenings from March to September.
