## **The FCCC 2023 Cycling Challenge**

To encourage more regular participation in Club Rides\*\* we will be awarding the following 2023 club achievement awards.

(\*\*a "Club Ride" is a ride offered by a member, i.e. acting as a ride leader, through the FCCC Club Website and on the FCCC Members Facebook Group)

Each award will be a part of a fun set of sew-on badges. We are still in the process of making the badges so examples are not currently available.

They will be awarded at the CNOTY in 2024.

The qualification criteria are set out below:

### **The 100 Club (12 rides)**

Ride twelve Club 100km road rides per calendar year. Eight must be ridden each in a separate calendar month – the remaining four may be ridden in any other month/months.

### **The FCCC Zwift Racing Badge (60% of races)**

Ride a minimum of **60%** of Zwift races for the club (representing any category of FCCC Team) in any calendar year. As a note, for 2022 this would have represented a target of 16 races, in the Zwift Racing League competition.

In the event that FCCC participates in other online competitions (or if, for example, ZRL is disbanded for any reason) we may set a new target.

## **The FCCC TT Award (16 rides)**

Ride a minimum of **16** FCCC Club TTs in any calendar year.

## **The FCCC Trails Award (24 rides)**

Ride at least 24 FCCC Club Off Road rides in any category (e.g. Easy Trails, Easy Trails + or DIRT) in any calendar year, with at least one per calendar month.

## **The FCCC Gold Award**

In addition to the above - we will be also be handing out the ultimate "FCCC Gold Award" to any member achieving all FOUR badges in any calendar year.

These challenges will intentionally require effort on your part but are, in our view, all achievable.

Note: Members claiming these awards will need to submit their claims (plus supporting evidence) by 15 January 2024 to allow us time to review and collate the claims in time for the awards presentation at CNOTY 2024.
